Goals

Our mission is to honour and sustain Tongan culture while promoting unity within the community through Rugby League. We aim to cultivate a strong sense of pride in our Tongan heritage among players and their families, while consistently adhering to our fundamental principles of Faith, Culture, and Respect.

This initiative seeks to establish pathways and opportunities for both junior and senior players of Tongan heritage in the rugby league arena. We plan to accomplish this by encouraging active involvement in key annual events, including the Mi Electric Sika Manu Cup and QPICC.

By offering a platform for youth to participate in cultural expressions such as song, dance, and historical learning, alongside their enthusiasm for rugby league, we strive to create a supportive environment that fosters a connection to their Tongan identity. Our aspiration is that, by the conclusion of the season, players will have developed a stronger bond with their cultural roots.

**Registration Process**

- All players must register via the Mysideline portal to qualify for selection in representative teams.
- Regions must email nomination lists for all age groups to info@qtrl.com.au 5 days before October 11, 2025, to verify player registration.
- Participation is contingent upon player registration; unregistered players are ineligible.

Selection Process

- Affiliated regions must submit a list of players (aged U13s to Opens) of Tongan heritage for QTRL selection, including player names and jersey numbers.
- Failure to provide the required list may lead to players being overlooked for selection. Ensure compliance with all registration and submission deadlines to facilitate a smooth selection process.

Preparation Process

- QTRL provide game balls for all games.
- Regions are responsible for game touch judge (except u8,u10,u19s & opens), league safe & score keeper (managers)
- Each team is allotted 2 minutes for Sipi Tau before the game commences on time.
- Senior team managers must collect score cards from competitions tent prior to your first game.

Points System

Two trophies will be awarded:

- Cultural & Senior Champions
 - Region Himi / Veesi lauloto
 - Region Performance and teunga during opening ceremony
 - Looking for Unity & Enthusiasm.
 - Win = 2 points
 - Draw = 1 point
 - Loss = 0 point
 - Each Team Manager must complete the scoring card for every senior match (u13s-opens) and submit it to the Games Table for tallying. To prevent any bias, two scoring cards should be provided for each game.
 - Please note only senior games will be scored.



FAKA'APA'APA - RESPECT

- Regions are tasked with upholding our cultural values among players and staff, both during and outside of matches.
- Teams are required to promptly enter the field upon the referee's whistle. Failure to comply may lead to penalties at the referee's discretion, ensuring the smooth progression of scheduled games
- It is the responsibility of each region to maintain cleanliness in their designated areas.
- Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- All players, volunteers, and spectators are expected to show mutual respect towards each other and game day officials.

Non-compliance with these regulations may lead to repercussions.

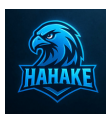
